The \$60,000 sale topper at the Banquet Sale 2021. Quarter Pounder features all we expect from Banquet, muscle expression, weight for age, heavy flesh, deep bodied and power.

In terms of what we see today Quarter Pounder combines all the EBVs traits with phenotypic style.

For those that love to review pedigrees Quarter Pounder is solid gold -

- Four crosses of the Kiwi Dream M41+92, matriarch to many great Angus cattle including being gdam of Dream Y301
- Four crosses of Hingaia 469.

The pedigree is loaded with great Banquet ancestry and features.

Banquet sale toppers of the past sales Waltana (\$19,000), Xplanation X060 (\$30,000) and TimeFrame (\$50,000).

Quarter Pounder's sire Gaffa G4, "adds length of body and extension of neck to his progeny while maintaining the traditional depth and thickness of the Banquet beast" (Banquet reference sires 2021). Gaffa's dam Dream E096 was purchased for \$38,000 at the Vermont Dispersal.

Q252's dam, L131, has calved each year with a 366 day spread and gdam J248 has calved every Spring.

Quarter Pounder Q252 is potentially the star sale bull of 2021, as he covers all bases of royal pedigree, great phenotype with matching EBVs!
